NHS HEALTH BOARDS AND SPECIAL HEALTH BOARDS REMUNERATION INCREASE 2014-15 : CHAIRS AND NON- EXECUTIVE MEMBERS

1. I am writing to advise you of the revised annual rates of remuneration payable to Chairs and other Non-Executive members of Health Boards, Special Health Boards and Healthcare Improvement Scotland. Other Health Bodies will be advised separately by their Scottish Government Sponsor Teams.

2. The revised rates reflect a 1% increase, in accordance with the Public Sector Pay Policy for 2014-15 and are set out in the table overleaf.
