CLARIFICATORY NOTE TO NHS HDL(2004)25:
TREATMENT OF TEACHING, TRAINING AND RESEARCH UNDER THE NEW CONSULTANT CONTRACT AND DEVELOPMENT OF MEMORANDA OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN UNIVERSITIES AND NHS BOARDS

- 1. Following the issue of the above HDL the Department has been asked to clarify paragraphs 11-13 of Annex A to the HDL in relation to dental consultants, both NHS and clinical academic.
- 2. It is recognised that dental undergraduate teaching has a different structure to that in medicine in that undergraduate dental students undertake a significant amount of active treatment on patients in clinics supervised by members of staff with a staff/student ratio varying from about 1:4 to 1:9.
- 3. Employers should ensure that dental undergraduate teaching can be undertaken in direct clinical care programmed activities. This is in accordance with guidance already issued in Annex C to NHS Circular PCS(DD)2004/2 dated 30 March 2004.
