Medicine Supply Alert Notice

PETHIDINE 50MG TABLETS

Priority: Level 2¹

Valid until: early to mid-December 2019

Issue

- 1. Teva and Martindale are out of stock of pethidine 50mg tablets. There are no alternative suppliers.
- 2. Teva anticipate resupply in week commencing 2 December 2019 and Martindale in mid-December 2019.
- 3. Unlicensed pethidine 50mg capsules are available from Martindale.

Advice and Actions

- 4. Patients without sufficient supplies of pethidine 50mg tablets to last until the resolution date, should be reviewed by a clinician to assess their ongoing need.
- 5. Where necessary, clinicians may wish to obtain specialist advice from local pain teams or substance misuse teams on alternative treatment options or dosage reduction.
- 6. For patients who require a supply of pethidine 50mg tablets, clinicians can prescribe the unlicensed pethidine 50mg capsules (see additional information below).
