Medicine Supply Alert Notice

Penicillamine 125mg and 250mg tablets

Priority: Level 2*

Valid until: Late March 2020

Issue

- 1. Penicillamine 125mg tablets are out of stock until late March 2020.
- 2. Limited supplies of penicillamine 250mg tablets are available through hospital pharmacies only.
- 3. Further supplies of penicillamine 250mg tablets for primary care are expected by the end of February 2020.
- 4. Unlicensed imports of penicillamine 125mg and 250mg tablets are available.

Advice and Actions

- 5. For patients with insufficient supplies during this time, pharmacy teams should consider providing unlicensed imports of penicillamine tablets (see additional information below).
- 6. Where unlicensed imports are not considered appropriate, please see the UKMi memo for further information (link below).

- 7. The following specialist importers have currently confirmed availability of unlicensed penicillamine tablets (please note, there may be other companies that can also source supplies):
