Medicine Supply Alert Notice

Convulex[®] (Valproic acid) 150mg, 300mg and 500mg capsules

Priority: Level 3^{*} update to MSAN (2019)31 Valid until: End May 2020

Issue

- 1. There is a supply issue with Convulex[®] (valproic acid) capsules due to a pack size update (switching from 100 to 30 capsules):
 - Convulex[®] 150mg capsules are **back in stock**.
 - Convulex[®] 300mg capsules are out of stock until the **end of May 2020**.
 - Convulex[®] 500mg capsules are **back in stock**.

Advice and Actions

- 2. Prescribers should consider prescribing double quantities of 150mg capsules where a 300mg dose is required. Alternatively where patients require a supply of 300mg capsules to be dispensed, pharmacists can substitute double quantities of 150mg capsules.
- 3. Prescribers and pharmacists are requested to discuss any change in treatment with patients and ensure appropriate counselling has been provided on any changes to their treatment regimen.
- 4. All healthcare professionals in primary, secondary or specialist healthcare services who prescribe and supply valproic acid capsules should work together to:
 - ensure that specialist neurology teams support colleagues in primary care if further advice is required;
 - make sure all female patients who continue treatment containing valproate are enrolled in the pregnancy prevention programme (PPP).
