Medicine Supply Alert Notice

Enalapril 20mg tablets (various suppliers)

Priority: Level 2*

Valid until: Early August 2020

Issue

- 1. All suppliers of enalapril 20mg tablets are out of stock until early August 2020.
- 2. Alternate strengths of enalapril (2.5mg, 5mg and 10mg) tablets remain available and will be able to support increased demand.
- 3. Unlicensed supplies of enalapril 20mg tablets can be sourced.

Advice and Actions

- 4. Where patients have insufficient supplies to last until the re-supply date, prescribers should:
 - work with local pharmacy teams to understand availability of alternative strengths and issue a
 prescription to make up the required dose of enalapril; or
 - consider prescribing unlicensed imports, if supplies of enalapril tablets are unavailable. Prescribers should work with local pharmacy teams to ensure orders are placed within appropriate time frames as lead times may vary (see additional information).
