Medicine Supply Alert Notice

Tuberculosis (TB) oral agents

Priority: Level 2*- update to MSAN (2020)77 Valid until: Various - please see table below

Issue

- 1. Since August 2019 a number of oral TB agents have been impacted by supply issues. The supply picture has stabilised, and the majority of these issues have now resolved.
- 2. Regular updates will no longer be issued.
- 3. Please see the table in the 'Additional Information' section for the latest stock positions, suggested management plans and anticipated dates for re-supply.

Advice and Actions

- 4. Pharmacy procurement, clinical teams (including prescribers, TB nurses and clinicians) and any outsourced partners should work together to ensure that:
 - stock holding of TB agents is reviewed regularly;
 - alternatives, as advised in the summary table below, are ordered for the products that are in short supply;
 - prescriptions are amended in cases where the usual/preferred product is unavailable so that treatment is not delayed or interrupted;
 - Boards do not implement management plans that are not in line with the advice given within this document as that may precipitate further out of stock periods;
 - patients are appropriately counselled about changes to their usual/expected medication; and
 - if products that have not been flagged as out of stock cannot be obtained by Boards, this is escalated to the NSS Procurement team.
