## **Medicine Supply Alert Notice**

## Acetazolamide SR 250mg capsules

Priority: Level 2\*

Valid until: until May 2021

#### Issue

- 1. Acetazolamide SR 250mg capsules are out of stock until May 2021.
- 2. Acetazolamide immediate release 250mg tablets remain available and can support an uplift in demand.
- Limited supplies of unlicensed imports of acetazolamide SR 250mg capsules have been sourced.

#### **Advice and Actions**

- 4. For patients with insufficient supplies, clinicians should consider prescribing acetazolamide 250mg tablets.
- 5. See the UKMi memo (link below) for further advice about management and switching from acetazolamide modified-release capsules to immediate release formulations.
- 6. If acetazolamide 250mg tablets are not appropriate, consider prescribing one of the following unlicensed medicines:
  - acetazolamide SR 250mg capsules
  - acetazolamide oral suspension (various strengths available)
