Medicine Supply Alert Notice

Chloral Hydrate 143.3mg in 5ml oral solution

Priority: Level 2^{*} Valid until: September 2021

Issue

- 1. Chloral hydrate 143.3mg in 5ml oral solution is out of stock until September 2021.
- 2. Specials manufacturers have confirmed they can manufacture chloral hydrate 143.3mg in 5ml oral solution to meet demand of the licensed product.

Advice and Actions

- 3. Where patients have insufficient supplies, clinicians should:
 - review ongoing need for treatment;
 - prescribe 143.3mg in 5ml chloral hydrate solution as a special if ongoing treatment is deemed necessary (see Additional Information).

- 4. The following specials manufacturers have confirmed they can manufacture chloral hydrate oral solution (please note, there may be other companies that can also manufacture this product):

 - Target Healthcare 143.3mg in 5ml oral solution*

* Please note these products are not batch manufactured and the supplier will only provide a certificate of conformity (CoC). Suppliers providing batch manufactured products will provide a certificate of analysis (CofA).
