Medicine Supply Alert Notice

Gentisone HC[®] (Gentamicin 0.3% w/v and Hydrocortisone acetate 1% w/v) Ear Drops

Priority: Level 2^{*} Valid until: w/c 25th October 2021

Issue

- 1. Gentisone HC[®] ear drops will be out of stock until w/c 25th October 2021.
- 2. Alternative combination topical ear products containing an aminoglycoside with a steroid remain available.

Advice and Actions

3. Clinicians should:

- not initiate new patients on Gentisone HC[®] ear drops;
- consider prescribing an alternative combination topical ear product containing an aminoglycoside with a steroid, ensuring that the patient is not intolerant to any of the ingredients (see Additional Information); and
- if the above option is not considered appropriate or for patients with complex disease, advice should be sought from specialists on management options.
