Medicine Supply Alert Notice

Ethinylestradiol 20microgram / Drospirenone 3mg (Eloine®) tablets

Priority: Level 2^{*} Valid until: late August 2023

Issue

- 1. Ethinylestradiol 20microgram / Drospirenone 3mg (Eloine[®]) tablets are out of stock from late-June 2023 until late-August 2023.
- 2. Alternative combined oral contraceptives (COC) remain available and will be able to support increased demand.

Advice and Actions

- 3. Where patients have insufficient supplies to last until the re-supply date, prescribers should:
- review patients to determine if this is still the most suitable therapy;
- consider prescribing an alternative COC, ensuring that the patient is not intolerant to any of the excipients and is counselled on the dosing regimen required (see Additional information below).

Clinical Information

- 4. Ethinylestradiol 20microgram / Drospirenone 3mg (Eloine[®]) tablets are the only drospirenone containing COC that contains ethinylestradiol at this dose. Other brands contain 30 micrograms ethinylestradiol per tablet (see table 1). These could be considered as suitable alternatives for many women. However, for women considered to be at increased risk of arterial thrombolic disease (such as increasing age, higher BMI) then it might be considered more appropriate to select a COC which contains 20microgram of ethinylestradiol with a different progestogen (see table 1). If prescribing a preparation with a different progesterone, the suitability of this should be considered as there is differing risk of venous thromboembolism with different progesterones.
