Summary of the amendments made to SFE effective retrospectively from 1 April 2013, issued on 16 January 2014.

Part 1 – Global Sum and Minimum Practice Income Guarantee

- Change to the Global Sum from £408.9 million to £409.3 million to take account of the adjustment to the transfer to the Global Sum of the Organisational Core Standard Payment.
