Summary

Distribution of Pachymeters to Optometry Practices in Scotland

Funding for Pachymeters

- 1. Following publication of the SIGN Guidelines on Glaucoma referral and safe discharge in March 2015, the Cabinet Secretary for Health, Wellbeing and Sport announced in June 2015, funding as part of the Primary Care Fund to purchase pachymeters for every optometry practice in Scotland.
- 2. Following a procurement exercise carried out by NHS National Procurement, Keeler has been awarded the contract as 1st ranked supplier to supply optometry practices with an Accutome Pachpen Pachymeter.

Distribution of the Pachymeters

- With the award now being made public, Keeler has advised that they will provide pachymeters to NES and all NHS Boards, except NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde and NHS Lothian by 27th January 2016.
- 4. Pachymeters will then be provided to NHS Greater Glasgow & Clyde and NHS Lothian by 22nd February 2016.
- 5. Keeler and Optometry Scotland will be in touch with practices in due course to arrange for the delivery of the pachymeters. Please visit the Optometry Scotland or Keeler websites for more information.
