COMMUNITY PHARMACIST SUPPLEMENTARY AND INDEPENDENT PRESCRIBING CLINICS: UPDATE ON FUNDING ARRANGEMENTS FOR 2016-17

Summary

1. This Circular informs NHS Boards and community pharmacy contractors of the intention to continue funding for Community Pharmacist Supplementary and Independent Prescribing Clinics in 2016-17.

Background

- 2. Circular PCA(P)(2016) 6 advised Boards of their provisional share of funding for Supplementary and Independent Prescribing Clinics in 2016-17.
- 3. Following receipt of Boards plans for clinics in 2016-17 the share of funding has been adjusted and the final amounts are set out in the attached Annex.

Details

- 4. The funds available for each Health Board to be deployed for clinics for the period April 2016 March 2017 are detailed in the Annex.
- 5. Through redistribution of surplus funds, some Boards are receiving a small additional resource to enable the expansion of clinics. These additional funds are available for 2016-17 only. The funds are intended only for the purposes of Community Pharmacist Supplementary and Independent Prescribing Clinics.
