COMMUNITY PHARMACY CONTRACT: INFRASTRUCTURE SUPPORT – STAFF TRAINING

Purpose

1. This circular provides NHS Boards and community pharmacy contractors with details of the financial support being made available for staff training for the financial year 2017-18.

Detail

- 2. Funding for staff training is available to community pharmacy contractors in two parts: **Part A** is financial support for specific courses; **Part B** is financial support to facilitate effective uptake of Over the Counter (OTC) Consultations training.
- 3. Funding for staff training will be met from the centrally held Pharmaceutical Services line.

PART A: SUPPORT FUNDING FOR SPECIFIC COURSES

- 4. The courses for which support funding is available are:
 - Pharmacy Services Level 2: NVQ/SVQ;
 - Pharmacy Services Level 3: NVQ/SVQ;
 - Accredited Checking Technician: NPA Accuracy in Dispensing Training Module or equivalent; and
 - SQA Professional Development Award (PDA) in Final Accuracy Checking by Pharmacy Technicians

Claims for Part A

- Each contractor, i.e. each community pharmacy, will be able to claim £800 as a contribution towards their costs in putting a permanent member of their staff through one or more of the courses listed above. No more than £800 per contractor is payable and claims must be submitted by the date detailed in paragraph 8 below.
- The claim and payment process will be managed by NHS Education for Scotland (NES) Pharmacy with resources available with immediate effect.
- 7. Payment will be made on submission of evidence that a member of the claimant/contractor's staff is about to commence, has commenced or has completed a listed course that was booked from 1 April 2017 onwards. Eligible evidence will be one or more of the following documents:
- Copy invoice of the cost of the training course;
- Letter of registration to the course signed by the training provider; or
- Copy certificate of course completion.
- Claims should be submitted, on the form attached at Annex A together with 8. the required documentation, to Anne Watson, NES (see address details on the form) by **30 November 2017**.

Training completed between 1 December 2017 and 31 March 2018

9. Contractors will also be able to submit claims for courses commenced or completed during the period 1 December 2017 - 31 March 2018. A separate circular will be issued setting out the arrangements and deadlines for those claims.

PART B: FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO FACILITATE EFFECTIVE UPTAKE OF OVER THE COUNTER (OTC) CONSULTATIONS TRAINING

- 10. Circular PCA(P)(2017)1 provided details of a new training resource for community pharmacy staff, 'Effective management of over-the-counter (OTC) consultations', developed to help optimise management of OTC consultations. A hard copy of the resource was sent to every community pharmacy.
- A second part to this training is currently in development by NES. This will 11. comprise a workbook, 'Improving the quality of over-the-counter (OTC) consultations' with which community pharmacists can engage their team members to develop their practice and knowledge. The resource will focus on OTC product requests i.e. consultations which involve a customer/patient requesting a product by name, rather than seeking advice for the treatment of a condition or symptom. Product requests constitute the majority of OTC consultations and are associated with lower quality management compared with advice requests.

A copy of the workbook will be sent to every community pharmacy in Scotland in February 2018.

Payment for Part B

- 13. Contractors on the Pharmaceutical List as of 1 January 2018 will be entitled to a one-off payment of £100 which is a contribution towards releasing staff time to undertake the training pack. The payment will be made in January 2018 dispensing, paid at the end of March 2018.
- Community Pharmacy Scotland has been consulted on the terms of this 14. circular and the Drug Tariff has been amended.

 - Copy this circular and Annex to all community pharmacy contractors on their pharmaceutical lists;
 - Note the financial arrangements set out above.
- 16. Community pharmacy contractors are asked to:
 - Note the content of this circular and where they wish to claim support funding for Part A, to do so using the form attached as Annex A and in accordance with paragraphs 7 and 8 above.
